As I'm sure you are aware, the current situation in Ukraine continues to deteriorate. Each day, homes and businesses are being destroyed, families are being displaced, and both civilians and soldiers are in immediate need of supplies ranging from basic necessities to first aid supplies and advanced medical equipment.

As shared last week, Hunterdon Healthcare is committed to helping our friends, families, and neighbors across the ocean. Under the leadership of Patrick Gavin, our president, and chief executive officer, Hunterdon Healthcare is leading a collaborative effort with the New Jersey Hospital Association (NJHA) and the Ukrainian National Women's League of American (UNWLA), to assist with the mobilization and international transport of much needed medical supplies for Ukrainian hospitals.

Beginning on March 9, 2022, hospitals from across New Jersey will join Hunterdon Healthcare by sending their medical supply donations to a UNWLA warehouse in Port Reading, NJ, where they will be packaged and immediately transported by air to a receiving station in Poland for distribution to Ukrainian hospitals. Hunterdon Healthcare's contribution will be a shipment of medical supplies estimated at a minimum of \$20K.
