As many of you may remember from the Annual Meeting, Holy Spirit's "faith budget" for 2023 had a \$50,000 shortfall. Early predictions are that we will end 2023 with a less than \$40,000 shortfall. In the spirit of full disclosure, we want to share a few specifics about giving in 2023, as you prepare to prayerfully consider your commitment for 2024:

o CHS currently has 120 active households in our congregation.

o 60 of those have made a pledge commitment for 2023.

____ I/we would like to receive a book of giving envelopes.

o There are an additional 20 households who actively give on a regular basis.

We understand that everyone is in a different financial situation. However, if every active household in our congregation were to give \$5 more a week than you are currently giving, we could substantially close the gap between our "faith budget" and our operating expenses for 2024.
